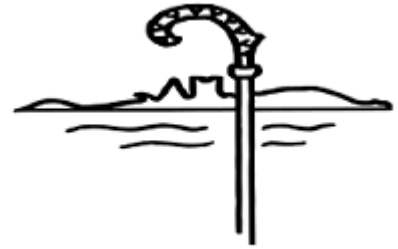


News from St. Fillan's July 2021
