They will meet with each church but it will take some time to for them to reach a decision.

As part of the changes St Fillan's is to be in a **Cluster/ Area/ Grouping** with Dalgety, Inverkeithing, North Queensferry and Rosyth churches. Meetings are taking place between treasures, property conveners etc.

The **Christian Aid Coffee Morning** was back, it was a great success, it raised £1612, thanks to all who helped.

The **minister** is still off on long term sick.
