The process of calling three **ministers** to the five congregations of **Fife: Forthview Parish Church** comprising St Fillan's Aberdour, Dalgety, Inverkeithing, North Queensferry and Rosyth congregations has started! The job has been posted on the Church of Scotland website and the Parish Profile is available on the Forthview Church's website.

The **nominating committee** has been elected comprising 13 members from all five congregations, including two from St Fillan's. All the information dealt with by the nominating committee is confidential so no feedback will be given until a Sole Nominee is selected.

There are to be three **ministers**, one with responsibility for St Fillan's and Dalgety and living in the Aberdour Manse, one for Inverkeithing and North Queensferry living in the Dalgety manse, and one for Rosyth living in the Rosyth manse. It is expected that the three ministers will work as a team. The Kirk Session agreed that applications can be made from ministers in same sex relationships.

We continue to enjoy the variety in our **Services**. We especially thank our own worship group, Mark Evans and Rev Chris Shreeve. Chris will take the **communion service** on Sunday 23rd June – all are welcome. Unfortunately Chris will be stepping down from taking the services, his last service will be on Sunday 30th June – we will miss him.
